This information can be found in **Title 12 Section 313(3) of the City Stormwater Ordinance** and in **Chapter 7 and 8 of the Clarksville Stormwater Management Manual**.

Part V

Section 3 A. (#12)

This question requested information regarding the procedures in place for receipt and consideration of information and complaints submitted by the public, however, the form did not provide a text box to include this information. Complaints and information from the public are received in various ways. They can be received through email, phone call, in person or through the online service request form. The complaint information is recorded by the NPDES Coordinator, Inspectors and/or administrative staff on a complaint form either electronically or written. A desktop review is performed by the NPDES Coordinator, Inspectors and/or administrative staff to determine if the complaint is within the jurisdiction of the City and if other department(s) such as Gas and Water or Building and Codes should be notified. If needed, the site in question is then investigated.
